

Corrections and Additions

After the initial release of this report, the Ohio Office of Budget and Management informed Policy Matters Ohio that one of the figures it previously supplied was incorrect. Decisive Systems Technology Ltd., shown in Table 1 to have received \$9,919,524 from the state in fiscal 2001, in fact received a total of \$466,730. The Department of Job & Family Services spent more than any other agency purchasing services from Decisive Systems, for a total of \$296,110. It was one of three agencies which purchased services from the company during the year.

Separately, Sophisticated Systems Inc. said that its sales of services to the state were much less than the \$11,423,229 listed in Table 1. Besides providing services, the company also sells computer equipment to the state.
