

Some tax breaks Ohio could do without

The “**Bambi Exemption**” for sales of materials used in structures for captive deer, approved in 2011.



A credit **on beer taxes** for importers and brewers if they pay a few weeks in advance, in place since 1963.



A cap on sales tax paid on **jet timeshares** bought by wealthy Ohioans.



A 50-year-old exemption for utilities to buy **pollution-control equipment**, much of it now mandated.
